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DON'T FORGET

Rules for liquids

Carrying liquids in hand baggage \ [Learn More](#)

You may carry liquids, gels, and aerosols in your carry-on baggage in accordance with the published regulations

Liquid containers must hold no more than 100 ml.

These containers must be placed in a clear, sealable, 20x20 cm plastic bag with a volume that does not exceed 1 L. It must be shown to security staff while going through airport security.

Each passenger can only carry one clear plastic bag.

If you would like or need to carry medicine in your carry-on baggage, please ensure it is in its original packaging. Please also carry a medical report confirming need to use this medicine, and present it to security staff as required.

In order to carry baby food in your carry-on baggage, your infant must be traveling with you on the same flight. It should also be limited to an amount that your baby is likely to need for the duration of the flight.

At security checkpoints, security staff may request you show documentation verifying the exceptional case or taste your medicine, baby food, or liquid.

Restricted liquids

All liquids, including water, syrup, and drinks.

Creams, lotions, oils (including cosmetic oils), cologne, perfume, and all types of makeup (excluding solid lipstick)

Shaving cream, deodorant, and pastes, including toothpaste.

Foods and gels that are not completely solid, including jams, honey, yogurt, molasses, and purees.

Contact lens solution, shampoo, sprays, aerosols, and other similar products to those given above.

Check-in Notification

For operational reasons, your boarding pass must have been collected and your baggage checked within the period indicated before your flight's scheduled takeoff time.

Passengers who have not arrived at the departure gate before the boarding process has been completed will not be allowed to board the flight even if they are carrying their boarding pass.

You can collect your boarding pass from the self check-in kiosks.

Passengers who have printed their boarding pass and are checking baggage must check their baggage before the counters close.

If your baggage is in excess of your allocated limit, please take into account the time it will take to pay extra baggage fees when planning your journey to the airport.

The type of aircraft scheduled for a flight may change for operational reasons.

Due to operational procedures involved, any special requests (wheelchair assistance, special meal requests, etc.) must be made at least 24 hours prior to the flight.
